Your Gift

Residual Gift

After you have looked after your family and friends, you may choose to leave the remainder of your Estate to support the Catholic Church.

Percentage Gift

You can choose to give a percentage of your estate to support any part of the mission of the Catholic Church.

Specific Gift

A specific gift (also called a pecuniary gift) is for a specified dollar amount or a specific asset.

Endowment Fund

Endowments are perpetual funds that literally last forever. The principal gift is invested in perpetuity and will never be spent down, leaving it forever able to generate income.

Your Will

Our Catholic faith is woven through the many milestones in our lives, providing guidance, hope and strength.

Making a gift of any size through your Will can support the mission of your parish, the Catholic Church and the faith of future generations.

Recommended clause* for a bequest of any size to our Diocese:

“I give [amount/percentage/asset/item] to The Roman Catholic Trust Corporation for the Diocese of Rockhampton ABN 50 979 741 889 for the use and benefit of the general charitable, religious and educational purposes of the [insert full name of the Diocese or Appeal].

I direct that the receipt of the Financial Administrator for the time being of The Roman Catholic Trust Corporation for the Diocese of Rockhampton ABN 50 979 741 889 shall constitute a sufficient discharge to my trustee”.

After providing for your family, even a gift of just 1% of your estate can help support the mission of the Church.

Reflect on the ways your Catholic faith has influenced your life. Discuss your wishes with family and loved ones and seek professional legal advice before preparing or updating your Will.
